I am pleased to write to you to offer you the final report from our recent Ofsted inspection. The inspection was a one-day monitoring inspection, reviewing the school's progress since October 2019. This, of course, came on top of the remote inspection we had in January of this year.

The report focuses on the areas from the last report, and entailed a routine review of Safeguarding. The report speaks for itself – it is incredibly positive, and I am incredibly proud of all of the adults and children who have contributed to these findings. We should also note the powerful support of our Local Governing Body and of our Trust governance colleagues, who have also been of immense value.

We have now had two very successful inspections in the last few months, so I hope that fact will fill families with every confidence about our school's current provision, its direction, and its future!

The next inspection of our school will be a Section 5 full inspection, which will last for two days. It usually involves three inspectors. That inspection will review every aspect of school performance. We know that it will be at some point in the next 21 months, although I personally anticipate it to be a lot sooner than that! That is just my own personal prediction, and my football predictions never work out all that well – so feel free to take my view with a pinch of salt! Either way, we will be working hard every single day for the children, and will be ready whenever the call comes through!

So, we look forward to next year with excitement – and I'll be in touch very soon about other matters such as pick/ups/drop offs, school day timings and other similar aspects.
